1	<p>Any city in UK - Geneva (Meeting time at 12pm in Geneva airport) Flight to Geneva. Welcome by the Tour guide on arrival, excursion to the Cosmopolitan City and United Nations' European Headquarters Geneva – The Jet D'eau, The Flower Watch, Old Town, Church..... Geneva: international meeting place, the smallest of the world's metropolises, peace capital of the world.</p>
2	<p>Geneva – Lausanne – Vevey - Montreux Lausanne: The geographical location of Lausanne could hardly be more picturesque. This, the Olympic capital, is built on three hills with the Lake of Geneva bathing its feet and a garland of vineyards around its shoulders. Officially named as the Olympic Capital in June 1994 by the International Olympic Committee, which headquartered in Lausanne since 1915. Here, we can go to visit Olympic museum. It tells the history of Olympism from antiquity to the present day, and the Movement's current life. Together with its research centre, it is the world's prime Olympic and documentation centre. Montreux -Vevey is about: breathtaking landscape, palm trees, vineyards, Alps and glacier, Belle Époque style and history, jazz, Savoir-Vivre and hospitality. Also known as the "Pearl of the Swiss Riviera" thanks to its micro-climate.</p>
3	<p>Interlaken – Jungfrqujoch – Luzern Interlaken: holds a prominent position among Europe's tourist resorts-enjoy picturesque view. Jungfrqujoch: –Top of Europe. To the Top of Europe by train, don't miss the tremendous view of Lauterbrunnen, Trummelbach Waterfall, Alps. On arrival to Jungfrauoch, the Aletsch Glacier, Ice Gateway, which link the Ice Palace and Iceland Luzern: the town with the highest quality of life in Switzerland! Once you've arrived, you may want to linger in the picturesque old town, which is car-free and small enough to be explored on foot - the medieval old town with its picturesque squares and towers, the Kapell bridge and the lion monument...etc.</p>
4	<p>Luzern – St Gallen – Liechtenstein - Zurich St Gallen: Visit historical old town with famous cathedral and abbey library (UNESCO World Cultural Heritage) and Rich cultural agenda with the well-known "Drei-Sparten" theatre, musicals, small groups and cultural events such as the St.Gallen Open-air Festival. Liechtenstein: Visit the Rhine Falls - the biggest waterfall in Europe. Zurich: Zurich is top for leisure and pleasure. Gentle hills, peaceful woods, the unpolluted lakes and rivers, picturesque villages - and all just a stone's throw from the Alps. Zurich is the ideal starting point for all kinds of varied excursions. * Enjoy the pretty old town, the trendy new Zurich West district and the glorious lake. * The famous Bahnhofstrasse and the Limmatquai are a shopper's paradise..etc. * Grossmunster, Zurich's most famous landmark and a symbol of the city * St. Peter's Church, with its eye-catching clockface, Europe's largest * Fraumunster, built in the 9th Century, was a convent, which later became a church. The beautiful stained-glass windows was designed by the Russian emigré Marc Chagall * Lindenhof, a small hill on the left bank of the Limmat offering a magnificent view of the old city, remains of the Roman "Turicum" were found</p>
5	<p>Zurich – Bern – Geneva- UK Bern: The Old Town of Bern, which figures on the UNESCO list of World Cultural Heritage sites has one of the longest "weatherproof" shopping malls in Europe under its six kilometres of covered arcades. The mediaeval atmosphere, with shops in the cellar vaults must be unique. Coach / minibus to Geneva Airport at 5pm, flight back to UK . Bon Voyage!</p>
